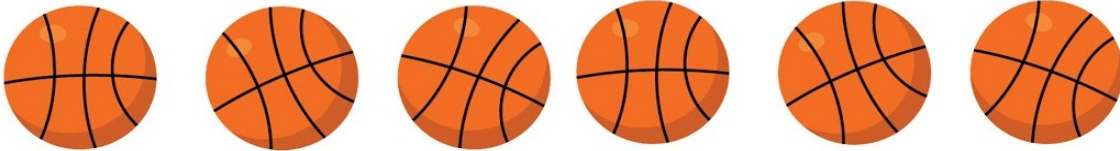

- If campers wish to bring a guest, they MUST call two days ahead for Director's approval and pay a \$30.00 fee
- All signups for field trips begin on the Monday of the week of the field trip. Field trip registration is open until the trip is full. Field trips have limited spaces, age restrictions, and are on a first come, first serve basis.
